Dear Valued Customer:

**We apologize for the confusion that the current tariff situation has been creating for all of us. Due to the 90 day pause on reciprocal tariffs from India, we have decided to decrease the Tariff Surcharge from 10% to 4%. Please keep in mind that we will still be paying the “baseline” 10% additional tariff on all goods coming in during this 90 day pause. Therefore, we have reduced our surcharge to 4%. Effective on May 1, 2025, any in stock orders that ship will have the "Import Tariff Surcharge" fee of 4% added to the invoice before shipping charges. Thank you for your patience.**

As you may already know, President Trump on April 2<sup>nd</sup> announced new tariffs on imports to the USA. Specifically on imports from India, the additional tariff rate has been set to 26% effective April 9<sup>th</sup>. We are hopeful that the government of India will actively work with the Trump administration to lower the tariffs that they charge on US imports, so this additional 26% tariff can be removed. We are actively monitoring the situation, and we'll assess our 10% Tariff Surcharge accordingly.

We have always believed in treating our retail partners fairly and our customers have always reciprocated. This event is just another challenge we collectively have to navigate.
